This plant has not operated since September of 2008. The plant was placed into operation today solely for the purpose of conducting the facilities annual Visible Emissions test

The 2006 inspection report made two recommendations. One to install a spray bar, vacuum shroud assembly or partial enclosure for the batching operations and two, to have VE testing performed as soon as possible. Both of these recommendations have been implemented. A spray bar and shroud assembly have been installed and VE testing was performed..
