Mr. Paul Knapp accompanied AQD staff on the inspection. The facility's general permit has expired so Mr. Knapp was informed that he was out of compliance. The facility also did not have their polyester resin/styrene usage records and AQD staff detected objectionable odors off the property. The facility is out of compliance and received a Warning Notice.
