INSPECTION FINDINGS		
<p>I stopped by the yard on my way to an inspection. It was windy today and this facility has received numerous complaints from a business across the street over the past few years. This is a yard where JVS accepts clean concrete from demolition jobs. The crusher is brought in on a temporary basis throughout the year to process the material left in the yard. Stockpiles of processed material stay on site on a constant or near constant basis. I met with Elzie who was the supervisor on duty. I observed upon arrival that the ground was wet and saturated in most places, especially where the truck traffic is entering and leaving the yard onto SR 60. The stockpiles were not wet and I explained to Elzie that general permit condition required JVS to keep the piles wet as well as the ground. Elzie explained that JVS is in the process of installing a perimeter and stockpile sprinkler system to address this issue. He showed me where a well has been drilled and a foundation is in place for a pump for the sprinkler system. I did not observe any significant fugitive emissions from the piles during my inspection.</p>
