**COMMENTS:** In a compliance inspection conducted on 12/17/2009, AQD staff observed operations at Phil Smith Chevrolet. Mr. Rich Gehris accompanied staff on the inspection. The facility has three spray booths (one truck spray booth) and one paint mixing room. Housekeeping was good and haz-mat storge was sufficient. Mr. Gehris stated that the facility will be switching some of its paints to water based paints. The paint supplier (sherman williams) will be running the VOC report for the facility and submitting it to the department.
