**COMMENTS:** ON NOVEMBER 19, 2007 AT 11:31 A.M., CHI-RUEY CHEN AND I VISITED THIS FACILITY TO CONDUCT THE ANNUAL COMPLIANCE INSPECTION. ON SITE WE MET OSCAR MENDOZA, THE FACILITY'S VICE-PRESIDENT. THERE ARE EIGHTEEN (18) ABOVE GROUND STORAGE TANKS CONTAINING GASOLINE AND DIESEL FUEL, MOTOR OIL, AUTOMATIC TRANSMISSION FLUID AND HYDRAULIC FLUID. FOUR (4) 30000 GALLONS GASOLINE ABOVE GROUND TANKS HAVE BEEN ADDED. AT THIS TIME THEY ARE NOT IN USE. MR. MENDOZA TOLD US THAT THEY ARE WORKING ON THE REQUIRED PERMITS. I DID NOT NOTICE ANY OBJECTIONABLE ODORS AROUND THE FACILITY.
