PART III: MAINTENANCE REQUIREMENTS – Rule 62-210.300, F.A.C.

COMMENTS: ON SEPTEMBER 3, 2008 AT 12:23 PM, I VISITED THIS FACILITY TO CONDUCT THE ANNUAL COMPLIANCE INSPECTION. OSCAR MENDOZA, THE FACILITY'S VICE PRESIDENT AND RESPONSIBLE OFFICIAL WAS OUT TO LUNCH.

THERE ARE TWENTY TWO (22) ABOVE GROUND FUEL TANKS CONTAINING GASOLINE, DIESEL FUEL, MOTOR OIL AND HYDRAULIC FLUID. FOUR (4) 30000 GALLONS GASOLINE TANKS ARE NOT INCLUDED IN THE AIR GENERAL PERMIT.

THE HOUSEKEEPING IS GOOD. THERE ARE NO OBJECTIONABLE ODORS AROUND THE FACILITY. ON SEPTEMBER 6, 2008, I SPOKE TO MR. MENDOZA TO REQUEST THE GASOLINE THROUGHPUT RATE RECORDS FOR THE LAST TWELVE MONTHS. AS OF SEPTEMBER 15, 2008, HE HAS NOT SUBMITTED THOSE RECORDS. A NOTICE OF VIOLATION WAS ISSUED TO MR. MENDOZA FOR THE REQUIRED RECORDS AND FOR CONSTRUCTING FOUR ABOVE GROUND FUEL TANKS WITHOUT THE APPROPRIATE PERMITS.
