INSPECTION COMMENTS:

The inspector met with Johnny Caps. Mr. Caps showed the inspector a copy of his application and a 2007 printing operations calendar he had received from the Department.

However, the calendar was not filled in with the material usage calculations and/or amounts. Mr. Caps explained that he was not knowledgeable of the procedures to maintain records.

The inspector had a discussion with Mr. Caps on recordkeeping. It was ascertained that Mr. Caps wanted to use the "materials usage approach" to recordkeeping.

The inspector would do a follow-up on the next inspection to observe the recordkeeping and see if it was performed in an acceptable fashion per rule. A compliance status will be assigned at that time.

The equipment was observed and appeared to be a non-heated offset lithographic machines (3 presses). Amount of printing chemicals onsite were small. The operation appears to be as described in the permit application. The units were not in operation during the inspection.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

• The facility should be maintaining records as described in the permit application (Rule 62-210.310 (4) (f), F.A.C.). The records will be checked for compliance on the next inspection.

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
