THIS FACILITY HAS THREE (3) SPRAYBOOTHS, ONE IS USED TO APPLY RESIN, THE OTHER ONE TO APPLY GELCOAT AND THE LAST ONE TO SPRAY PAINT METAL PARTS. THIS BOOTH WAS USED AS STORAGE WHEN THE FACILITY WAS INSPECTED ON OCTOBER 1, 2007. THE FACILITY HAS A FDEP AIR GENERAL PERMIT FOR POLYESTER RESIN OPERATIONS ONLY. I ISSUED A NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOR OPERATING THIS PAINT BOOTH AND ALSO FOR NOT PROVIDING THE RESIN AND GELCOAT USAGE FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2008. THE HOUSEKEEPING IS POOR.
