**COMMENTS:** In a compliance inspection conducted on 10/29/2008, AQD staff observed operations at Sonny's (Car Wash Factory). The facility assembles parts for car wash systems. Mr. Michael Bauer accompanied staff on the inspection. The facility has one spray booth and it is well maintained. The filters are changed as needed. Mr. Bauer submitted VOC usages and the facility is under the 44/lbs/day/VOC threshold. Records were excellent and housekeeping was good.
