

Such changes shall include: 1. Any change in the name, address, or phone number of the facility or authorized representative not associated with a change in ownership or with a physical relocation of the facility or any emissions units or operations comprising the facility; or [62-210.310(2)(d), F.A.C.] Comments: non applicable, no changes to ownership
			Equipment Changes . The owner or operator shall maintain records of all equipment changes. 


