			The facility's Authorized Representative changed from James DeLellis(co-owner) to Steven Higger (co-owner) in April
			after Mr. DeLellis retired. There was no notification provided to the Department. I informed Ken Beaver we needed
			written notification of the change immediately and reminded him of the permit requirement of notifying within 30 days
			of the change. Per Wayne Martin, no further action will be taken.

To avoid lapse of authority to operate, the owner or operator must submit the proper registration form and processing fee at least thirty (30) days prior to expiration of the facility's existing air general permit. The air general permit re-registration form shall contain all current information regarding the facility. [General Conditions - 62-210.310(3)(a), F.A.C.] Comments : The permit expires on 10/2/2015. A new notification form is required to be submitted no later than 9/2/2015.
