COMMENTS: I went to 1115 Main Street in Brooksville for an initial inspection of a relocatable concrete batch plant. This is a new general permit with a start-up date of April 1, 2011. The facility location on the permit (1115 Main Street, Brooksville) is an office building for L.R.E. Ground Services Inc. I met with Raymond Woolever who is the Chief Executive Officer for the company. Mr. Woolever informed me that the relocatable batch plant is still on-site and has not been used yet. He took me out to the parking lot where the relocatable batch plant is currently located. The batch plant is mainly comprised of two storage silos and a weigh hopper. The plant is run by electricity fed by an electric generator. Mr. Woolever told me that as of now, he has no plans to relocate and use the batch plant. I advised Mr. Woolever that he will need to send a Facility Relocation Notification Form to the Department when he plans to relocate the batch plant. I also told Mr. Woolever that he can call the Compliance Manager, Danielle Henry, if he has any questions regarding the rules for the relocatable crusher. I sent Mr. Woolever an email on 06/03/2011 with an attachment of the rules for concrete batch plants, and a reminder about VE testing. I have attached a picture which shows the inactive crusher in the parking lot of the office building. Since the concrete batch plant has not been in operation, the facility is currently in compliance.
