COMMENTS: Met with Mr. Dana Lind at Coggin Nissan at the Avenues. His operation is a mobil surface coating operation which is very small. He operates out of a small mobil trailer, he uses small amounts of paints and solvents for his mobil business. He does paint touch ups on vehicles and his coating usage of VOC content is very low. His usage per day of paints, primers, solvents and coatings is less than 12 - 20 onces a day and he does not work every day. Records of his usage of paints, primer, solvents and MSDS sheets were checked and his waste is stored in a metal container for proper disposal. No violations were noted at the time of inspection.
