**COMMENTS:** FDEP inspectors Marc Lovallo and Max Schwartz met with facility representatives Julie Bishop and Emely Riveria on-site. The facility began operation in September 2013. Temperature charts and maintenance records were reviewed and appeared to be in compliance with permit requirements. Ms. Riveria explained that she does weekly preventive maintenance checks on the unit and that Matthews (the manufacturer) is under warranty to do maintenance on the machine once a year, including calibration checks on the temperature monitoring system. A cadaver was loaded into the incinerator during the inspection. No objectionable odors or visible emissions from the stack were observed during that time. The facility is in compliance with its Air General Permit.
