Armando,

Since the date that Permit# 0050077-006-AC was issued on 04/06/2010, the last day of entitlement/registration for #0050077-004-AG is 04/05/2010.

Based on your e-mail, and based on the fact an AC was issued to this facility on 04/06/2010, and based on the compliance history as logged in the ARMS database which is reflective of the facility operating w/o a permit, I have changed the AG registration to reflect an expires date of 04/05/2010.

In the future, for AG entitlements issued here in Tallahassee, when it is determined that an AG entitled facility is operating w/o a permit and an AC is issued then all you need do is inform our office and we will adjust the AG expiration date to coincide with the AC permit issuance. This allow us to maintain accurate recordkeeping of those facilities entitled through this office.

If an AG facility was last entitled by your office, prior to Tallahassee assuming AG entitlement function, then by all means you may go ahead and make that adjustment, since your office is the keeper of those records.

The Glasstream boat building facility, ARMS ID# 0050077, in Panama City, Bay County has been operating for years under REINFORCED POLYESTER RESIN OPERATIONS air general permits. The facility was issued Air Construction permit 0050077-006-AC on April 16, 2010 after it was determined they no longer qualified for a GP. ARMS seems to show they still hold an active General Permit, 0050077-004-AG, effective 11/1/2007, expires 11/1/2012.

There is an ongoing legal action and we are concerned the active AG may confuse the courts. What is the proper procedure to have them surrender or have us rescind the AG permit?
