

Ready-mix concrete plant producing 120 cubic yards/hour [± 228 tons/hour] — 12 hours/day; 6 day/week; 52 weeks/year — emissions from cement/PenCem storage silos are controlled by bag houses mounted on the top of each silo.

Emissions Unit 01

Griffin Environmental Model 36-J

Model 36-J on top of both cement storage silo. The collector has 36 – 4" x 42" bags with 125 ft² of cloth area for an air to cloth ratio of 9:1. Baghouse operates when the silos are being filled. A shaker mechanism is utilized for purpose of cleaning the bags.

Emissions Unit 02

C&W Model CP-305

Top of silo mounted baghouse controlling one Pencem storage silo. Each collector has 8 -8" x 39" cartridges with 356 total filtration area with an air to cloth ratio(ACFM/Ft²) of 4.5. Bags are cleaned via pulse jet with timer.

Emissions Unit 03

C&W Model CP-5250

Central Dust Collector controlling weigh hopper and mixer loadout spout. The collector has fifteen 8" x 39" cartridges and a gas flow rate of 5250 CFM. The collector has an air to cloth ratio of 6.78 ACFM/ sq.ft. The cleaning mechanism is a pulse jet with timer.



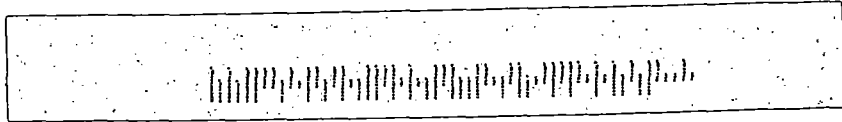
