### Description of Facility

Coast to Coast Foam Solutions uses polyurethane to spray on "foam shapes", which is the hard coat, and then is sprayed with a synthetics finish to complete the process of the "foam shape". There are two components to the polyurethane spraying process. The first component is the UTC "A" (Polymeric MDI) The second component is UTC "B" (Polyurethane resin blend with Amine Catalyst) part of the polyurethane system. They are in separate drums. The drums contents activated and pumped by a Graco Reactor E-30. This feeds a Graco Fusion AP spray gun, which mixes the UTC "A" and UTC "B" to form and dispenses the polyurethane. The spray gun sprays a light mist of liquid polyurethane on the foam shape. Coast to Coast Foam Solutions owns 2 of these spray guns. One sprayman is on staff at this time so only one spray gun is being used, the other is a back up. No activator is used. It dries on its own. The hard coat dries in minutes and the synthetics finish, depending on the humidity it may take up to 3 hours. No styrene and no fiberglass is used in our process. The booth used to spray the foam shapes is an 18' X 21' metal building with a roll up garage door which is open when in use and locked when not in use. The spray booth is considered to be a 3 sided building. There's a barrel fan in the door opening which is on during the spraying process as well as a large exhaust fan built into the south wall of the unit that pulls out the air for circulation. No filtering system is used. The MSDS sheet says VOC content-Not determined. Called Urethane Technology Company, Inc-they said not considered a VOC. The only emissions in the spray area: (VOC) mineral spirits, which are not used in any part of the coating or cleaning process, has 6.35 pounds per 1 gallon container, Bio Solve No VOC, Acetone No VOC, Pam cooking spray No VOC. Records of MSDS sheets and any other solvents or thinners will be kept on file through purchase orders and/or receipts for Coast to Coast Foam Solutions.

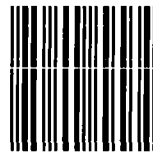
