

Please find attached the updated page 10. It has been updated to reflect that each silo has a capacity of 215 tons and the silo baghouse is mounted on top of the silo. The batchers have central mounted baghouses.

Stephanie,

Good afternoon. Thank you for your feedback and comments, and I apologize for any inconvenience that this may cause.

It does not matter how many times a facility has been registered in the past. Each time a facility is registered, or re-registered, or an ownership change takes place, we have to confirm that there has been no change of equipment as part of our review process. The forms are part of the rule and it clearly requests for identification of equipment for tracking purposes. The only way tracking can be done is by comparison of what's in our database, with the data submitted on the form. I cannot perform the required review without it.

As a sidebar and in this particular case, before Tallahassee assumed the Air General Permitting function in 2008, the previous permitting office did not enter any specific equipment identification for this facility into the data base.

I hope that this may clear up any misunderstandings that may have been created in the past.

 - c) **Type (Central, ground mounted, in-truss?)**

Please relay to your client that there is no need for concern unless we do not receive the information needed to complete the review within the mandatory thirty (30) day review & processing period. The purpose of the review & processing period is to give us ample time to make corrections to any incorrect or conflicting data, or to gather any missing data that is required when submitting forms for renewal. We are currently in the 19th day of that review period.

The highlighted items above are the only details remaining in the data gathering process. When I receive that information so I can complete my review and processing it will just be a matter of the expiration of the mandatory time period, which is thirty (30) days from the date of receipt. The date of receipt of PreCast's form was **JAN 14 2011**.

Stephanie,

Thank you for your inquiry.

PreCast Specialties Inc AGP Registration has not yet been approved. It is currently in the mandatory thirty (30) day processing and review period. It was received in our offices on 01/14/11.

Since the Air General Permit is a "permit by rule" we do not issue a permit or certificate per se. If and when the permit registration becomes effective at the end of the review period, a letter of acknowledgement is mailed, unless the entitlement to operate is denied.

The information which was supplied has been input in our ARM's database and is currently in a "PENDING" state for lack of proper identification of process and emission control equipment as requested on Page 10 of the form under the Description of Facility portion. Mr. Panetta has access to the data that has been supplied.

Typically the identification of equipment includes the following:

For each Plant: North and South

- 1) Silo Identification
 - a) # of silos and identify each (i.e.- cement, slag, flyash, north, south, east, west?)
 - b) capacity of each silo (Bbls, Tons, Cu Yds, etc.?)
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 - c) Type (Central, ground mounted, in-truss?)
- 3) Identification of all Emission control units (as in 1)c) and 2)b) & 2)c) above.

The form itself is currently being logged in another office and will be electronically scanned as soon as all information is received and at that time it will be returned to me and I can send a copy at that time. Once it is scanned, Mr. Panetta can retrieve it through the DEPNET intranet using the Air Document Handling (ADH) tool under applications.

If the requested information is not received prior to the end of the processing and review period I will have to deny the entitlement and I really don't like to do that, so I am asking for your assistance.

I made a call this morning to Mr. Stan Mora, General Manager (954-781-4040 x17) and left a VM message & phone number for a return call, and requesting that someone provide the equipment identification detail.

As soon as I get the registration form back in my office, I will be able to provide you with a copy.
