**Concrete Batch Plant – Operation of a Ready Mix Concrete Plant**

Design capacity is 176 tons/hour, 5 days a week. Approximately 2600 hours/year. Plant is Besser Appco Dry Batch Plant. Split silo with total of 100 tons storage. Also has 4500 lb. Cement Weigh Hopper with 3 cloth breather bags for ventilation. Cement silo has 2 – C&W Cp230 silo dust collectors with 4" overfill protection system with audible & visible alarm/timer and pinch valve.

Load rate on silo is 25 tons/hour. Truck load out area is controlled by a spray bar. Aggregate Storage Bins with 175 ton capacity, 4 compartment equally split bins with 6 cubic yard Aggregate Weigh Hopper.

**Block Plant Operation**

Design capacity is 8 tons/hour (420 Block/hour). Single cement silo with 27 ton storage capacity and 1500 lb. Cement Weigh Hopper. Emissions from silo controlled by C&W CP 230 dust collector with 4" overfill protection system with audible & visible alarm/timer and pinch valve. Emissions from Weigh Hopper controlled by single cloth bag filter.

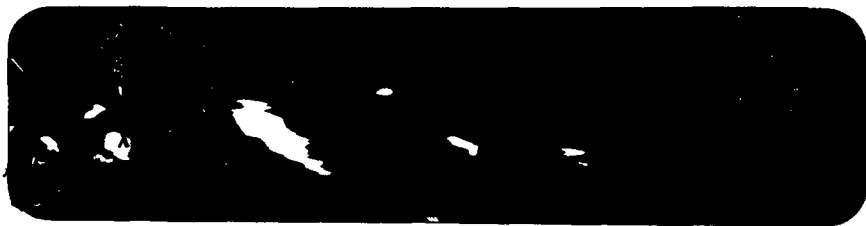
