

ANTI-FOULING PAINT APPLICATION (TYPICAL)

Lightly mechanically sand hull bottom in preparation for anti-fouling paint. Apply two full coats coating to the hull bottom and a third coat on the waterline. Scraping of marine growth and heavy sanding in corrosion areas as required.

BOTTOM PAINT APPLICATION ABRASIVE BLAST (TYPICAL)

- Lay down the environmental tarp and erect shrink wrap enclosure. Setup high output circulation fans.
- Sand sweep surface, heavy corrosion areas will receive extra blasting and spot priming
- Remove sand and debris from enclosure and disposal of properly
- Apply two coats of primer to the substrate
- Apply two coat of anti-fouling to the substrate

TOPSIDE PAINT (TYPICAL)

- Erect scaffold, enclosure and air filtration
- Repair all visible blisters.
- Hand sand exterior surface and apply 2 coats of primer to superstructure and hull.
- Hand sand primer & apply 2 coat of top coat to superstructure
- Apply two coats of top coat to hull
- Paint boot stripe and apply non-skid to decks
- Detail vessel and remove enclosure and scaffold.

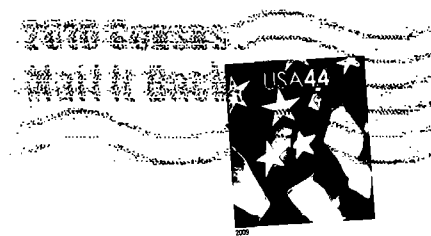
