

Substrate preparation is completed using a wipe down process with Kwik Dri 66 along with hand sanding. A Sherwin Williams low VOC Genesis coating system is used that include an epoxy primer and a urethane top coat. The coating system is applied in a filtered paint booth. Cleanup is done with thinner which is recycled.
