

Dear Mr. Klacko,

It was a pleasure to speak with you this morning regarding the subject item facility's renewal of the AGP.

On page seven (7) of the form under Material Usage, in the sub-block for **re-registration** it requests the following information.

If this is a **re-registration** for an existing surface coating operation, provide the highest monthly average of the daily quantity of volatile organic compounds in all coatings (solvents and thinners) used in the last five years. Indicate the month and year during which this usage occurred.

Your response was as follows:

"The highest monthly average was around 140 gallons (solvents + thinners) November, 2008."

The question is asking for "...the highest monthly average of the daily quantity of volatile organic compounds...".

If the number (140 gal) you have provided represents the usage during the whole month, then the number you have provided should be divided by thirty (30), representing the average number of days in a month to arrive at the daily average for that month.

If you would be so kind to confirm that 140 gals is the **daily average**, or provide a corrected number as the daily average, it would be greatly appreciated.

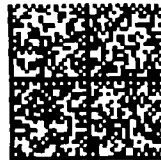
