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



The concrete block plant has the potential to manufacture approximately 3.5 million concrete blocks per year. The plant has a single cement silo with a baghouse to control particulate matter emission during silo loading.

The facility currently operates approximately 12 hours per day, 6 day per week and 52 weeks per year.

The facility has the potential to operate 8,760 hours per year.
