The Department has received the Title V General Permit Notification Form for the dry cleaning facility that you submitted on March 25, 1998.



## **FINAL NOTICE OF ANNUAL EMISSIONS FEE** **VIA: CERTIFIED MAIL WITH RETURN RECEIPT**

TO: User of Title V Air General Permit

Records in the Division of Air Resource Management indicate that during calendar year **1998** you owned or operated a facility that is a source of air pollution. In addition, under Rule 62-213(1)(g), F.A.C., failure to timely pay any required annual emissions fee, penalty, or interest constitutes grounds for revocation of the Title V Air General Permit.

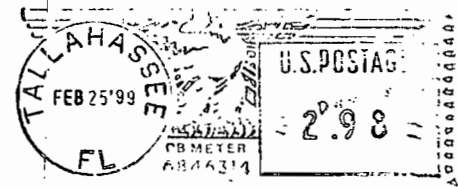
