Dear Mr. Caton:

This is to acknowledge that your notification of intent to use the authority of Rule 62-210.310 to operate your facility was received on February 21, 2008. We have assigned ARMS No. 0210112-001 to this facility.

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after 5 years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than 5 years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.

Description of Facility

Naples Daily News is a newspaper publisher which operates a printing facility located at 1075 Central Avenue, Naples, Florida. The operation is typical for a newspaper publisher and consist of pre-press and printing operations.

The printing process begins with images and text being transferred from computer to film. The film is then processed in an image setter, and the images and text are transferred from the film to aluminum printing plates. This constitutes the pre-press operations. Emissions associated with the use of plate developer are shown in the attached spreadsheet. Other chemicals used in the pre-press process do not contain volatile organic compounds.

From pre-press, plates are transferred either to the Didde Appolo 18 sheet-fed press (Didde press) or Gauss-Metro press. Both presses are non-heat set off-set presses. The Didde press is used to print newspaper inserts, commercial flyers, or in-house communication bulletins. The Didde press has the capacity to print 30,000, 8.5 x 11 sheets per hour, or 17,000, 11 x 17 sheets per hour. The Didde press utilizes US Inks and associated press chemicals, and the emissions from these materials are depicted in the attached spreadsheet. Gauss-Metro press is a newspaper printing press with a web size of 49-3/4 x 23-9/16 inches, and a maximum output of 70,000 newspapers per hour. The Gauss-Metro press utilizes Flint inks and associated press-chemicals, and the emissions from these materials are depicted in the attached spreadsheet. No other chemical usage takes place at the facility, except for insignificant usage of janitorial and maintenance supplies.
