

At our Miami plant we are constantly applying water to our plant to reduce any dust that may be left behind by our dust suppressants that our plants carry to reduce any excess of it. unconfined emissions is very well prevented by wind breaks that we also have on our batching plants. We carefully monitor all our baghouses to make sure everything is up to date.

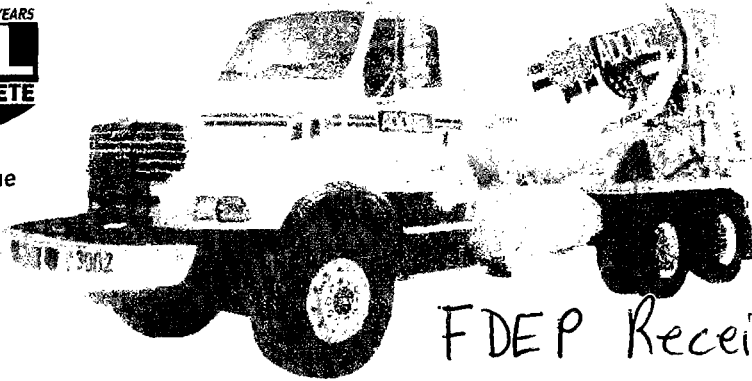
