Fuel Consumption

Pump Station # 1 (also known as the 4th Street Pump Station), has engine-driven pumps that convey raw sewage to the Central District Wastewater Treatment Plant for final treatment and disposal.

Six 550 horsepower Caterpillar Model 3508STD diesel-fueled engines each drive a pump to transport the raw sewage to the wastewater treatment plant.

Two Magnetek Model RDS1875 diesel-fueled engines, each driving a 150 kilowatt electrical generator, are also provided to meet the pump station's standby and emergency power requirements.

Fuel is metered by a single fuel meter between the on site fuel storage tanks and the bank of engines.

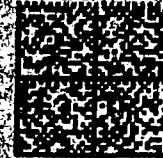
