
This is to acknowledge that your notification of intent to use the authority of Rule 62-210.310 to operate your facility was received on May 28, 2007. We have assigned ARMS Number 0251203-003 to this facility.

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after 5 years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than 5 years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.

### **Description of Facility**

Best Litho, Inc. (Best Litho) is a heatset offset lithographic printing facility which operates a Nebiolo Target I printer. The facility has a gas-fired catalytic incinerator which controls visible emissions.

The printing process at Best Litho begins with the image being digitally transferred to the proofing equipment for customer approval. The proofing equipment consists of digital units which do not contribute to overall emissions. Once approved, the images are digitally transferred to printing plates via computer in a process known as "computer-to-plate", or CTP. The image is "burned" onto an aluminum plate, and the plate is sent to the developer where the final image is developed. From here, the plates are sent to the press for final product printing. The entire pre-press process does not contribute to overall emissions, as no criteria pollutants (i.e. volatile organic compounds or hazardous air pollutants) are generated.

The printing press utilizes inks and press chemicals which contain VOC's. The total amount of inks and press chemicals is below 100,000 pounds. The overall VOC emissions for calendar year 2006 were less than 15 tons.

Other operations at the facility include propane-fired forklifts and warehouse operations, which are insignificant contributors to overall VOC emissions.

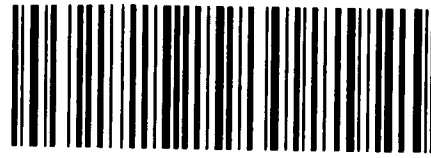

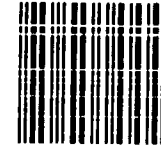
