Subject: Concrete Batching Plant Air General Permit Registration Form

Dear Mr. Jorge Fernandez,

It was a pleasure to speak with you yesterday regarding the subject item air general permit (AGP) registration form (see attached pdf file) which you submitted for your entitlement to operate a concrete batching plant at your facility.

After a cursory review of your registration form, I found that Page 10 was left blank and lacked specific equipment identification information which is requested on the form. As I mentioned during our conversation, Page 10 of the form requests identification of the process equipment (silos, batchers, mixers and truck load-outs, etc) as well as identification of any emission unit control equipment and what they serve. For your reference, I have highlighted the Description of Facility area on page 10 of the attached form.

The schematic diagram which was attached did provide general information with respect to process flow, but did not contain any emission control unit information, general or specific. Also, in order to track future equipment changes we need to know specific identifiers as outlined below.

Silo-specific identification should include such things as the manufacturer's name, model number, product stored, capacity of each unit in Bbls or cu.yd., silo location or number, and so forth.

Emission control unit-specific identification should consist of manufacturer's name and unit model number, the type of unit (either silotop, or ground mounted, and central baghouse or dust collector), filter type (cartridge or bag), filter sizes (sq ft of filter area, manufacturer name, model #, type of cleaning (shaker or pulse jet), etc.

In order to proceed with and complete the review and registration process for the air general permit I will need to have the requested information, preferably sooner, but no later than close of business on Tuesday, January 12, 2010.
