

The facility consists of an office, parking area, maintenance area and the precast plant.

The precast plant consists of one cement silo, conveying machinery, a concrete batch/mixer and the sand and stone holding area.

EU 001 is a baghouse mounted on the cement silo. The cement is transferred pneumatically into the cement silo. The emissions are controlled by a the silo mounted baghouse with a 99.8% control efficiency.

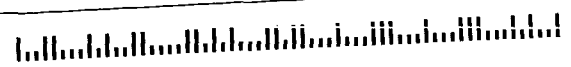
