Dear Mr. Korb,

Thank you for taking my call regarding the Surface Coating Operations Air General Permit Registration Form which you have submitted on behalf of the United States Coast Guard Hiltron located at Cecil Field, Hangar 13 in Jacksonville.

To recap our conversation, the Owner/Authorized Representative (O/AR) signature on the bottom of Page six (6) of the form does not appear to match that of CDR Jonathan Duff whose name appears at the top of the page as the Owner/Authorized Representative. In order for the application to be considered complete the signature at the bottom should reflect the individual listed as the O/AR at the top.

We have thirty (30) days from the original date of receipt of March 2, 2009 to make this correction, otherwise I will have to deny the permit, and I really don't want to have to do that. As I mentioned during our telephone conversation, I would prefer to make the correction earlier rather than later just to insure that the process will advance smoothly without interruption.
