Watco Mechanical Services (Watco) operates a railcar repair facility in Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida. Railcar repair includes, among other operations, the surface coating of railcar exteriors. The facility operates a single paint booth consisting of two spray guns that each spray a maximum of twelve (12) gallons per hour. The facility uses a large number of coatings according to customer specifications, but the average coating volatile organic compound (VOC) density is 2.64 pounds VOC per gallon of coating. The average thinning/cleaning solvent VOC density is 6.49 pounds VOC per gallon of solvent. The facility's operating schedule varies according to customer demand; however, Watco will maintain monthly usage records to ensure compliance with Rule 62-210.310(4)(c)(2)(a), which limits total quantity of VOC emissions to 44 pounds per day averaged monthly. The records will also demonstrate Watco's compliance with the rule's limits on Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs): less than 10 tpy for any single HAP and less than 25 tpy for any combination of HAPs.
