

Truck batching is controlled by a load shroud.

A C&W reverse air Model AR-170 central dust collector is located at ground level and collects dust from each of the silos and the truck batching process. The dust collector has a 15 HP blower with 8000 cfm capacity and 72 bags in two compartments.

Facility currently operates under permit 0330070-006-AG.
