Water sprays are used on aggregate piles to reduce emissions.

Spray bar is used on Plant #2.

Both plants are equipped with gum rubber boots to reduce dust emissions while loading trucks.

Loading areas are paved. Parking areas for trucks are crushed concrete base material.

Aggregate is stored in 3-sided concrete wind breaks, 10-12 feet high

Aggregate piles within these wind breaks are kept below the height of the walls.

Yards, drives and affected areas are swept and or watered to help keep fugitive emissions at a minimum.

Description of Facility

Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the concrete batching plant operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. Describe all air pollutant-emitting processes and equipment at the facility, and identify any air pollution control measures or equipment used. These are existing concrete batch plants using cement/flyash, aggregate consisting of rock and sand and water as raw materials.

Normal maximum business hours are 13 hr/day Monday through Friday, 8 hr/day on Sat, and 52 weeks/year, but facility requests that operating hours be unlimited.

Expected amounts of materials to be used yearly are:

Plant #1: cement - 40,000 TPY, flyash - 8,000 TPY, stone - 200,000 TPY and sand - 140,000 TPY.

Plant #2: Cement - 8,000 TPY, flyash - 2,000 TPY, stone - 50,000 TPY and sand - 25,000 TPY.

Plant #1 is located in the rear of the property and has of 2 silos. The cement silo is a split silo. The second silo is for flyash. Emissions from Plant #1 are controlled by a C & W central dust collector, Manufacturing & Sales Model RA 170.

Plant #2 is located nearest Hwy 95A and has of two silos (one for cement and one for flyash). Emissions from each silo is controlled by a McNeilus baghouse, Model SFV270 located atop each silo.

Cement/flyash is brought to plant via truck tankers and pneumatically pumped into silos.

Aggregate is brought in via trucks and stored on site in 3-sided concrete wind breaks, from there it is loaded into aggregate bins using front-end loader(s) when needed.

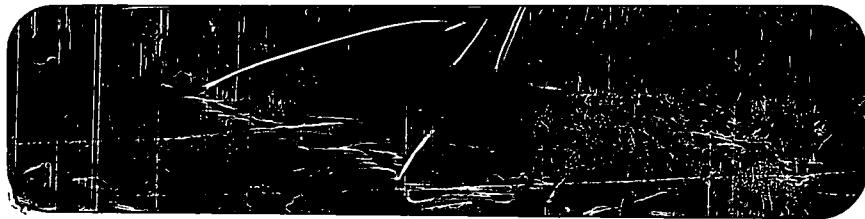
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
