We have 4 Aggregate Bins (2 for Sand & 2 for Rock) and one 85 Ton Silo. The sand & rock are conveyed to the mixer. The cement is augered to the pan mixer. We have one Pan Mixer, a Voeller Model #CM650VB, serial #200VM01. Once cement, sand & rock are in the pan mixer, it can be dumped into the Hawkeye Pipe ++ machine to make pipe or it can be conveyed to the Besser M80P2 ribbon blade mixer. That mixer is used for making our precast manholes & boxes.

There are no numbers on the aggregate bins or silo. These were bought from a shutdown plant in Tenn. They have been reskinned & there are no markings present.


