

Description of Facility Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the concrete batching plant operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. Describe all air pollutant-emitting processes and equipment at the facility, and identify any air pollution control measures or equipment used. This is a two silo concrete batching facility. There is one 100-ton silo (Silo 2) containing cement only and one 130-ton silo which is split 60% cement (Silo 1A) and 40% flyash (Silo 1B). All silo hoppers are pneumatically loaded from trucks. Particulate emissions from silo filling are controlled by baghouses. Each silo has a C & W Model RA-120 baghouse. Batching and truck loading emissions are controlled by a C & W Model CP-LPR-6-S dust collector. Each RA-120 dust collector contains forty-eight bags. The CP-LPR-6-S dust collector contains 6 seventy-two inch cartridges.

Reasonable Precautions to Prevent Emissions of Unconfined Particulate Matter 21101 Cortez Blvd., Brooksville, Hernando County, Florida

B.E.T.ER Mix, Inc. will at all times take reasonable precautions to prevent its Cement Batch Plant and associated facilities from emitting unconfined particulate matter. These precautions will include:

- 1) Maintaining and operating all air pollution control equipment required by the General Permit.
- 2) Watering roads as necessary to prevent vehicular traffic from entraining dust.
- 3) Posting and enforcing a 5 miles per hour (mph) speed limit in all areas.
- 4) Performing regular maintenance of roads, yards, and parking areas to prevent accumulation of dust.
- 5) Training equipment operators to minimize drop heights during loading and unloading operations.
