

The Safety Officer will provide the following reasonable precautions to be used to prevent unconfined emissions at the facility:

--Conduct a visible emissions test prior to submitting this application for an initial air operation permit, and annually thereafter.

--Conduct general monthly inspections of road, parking areas, stock piles, equipment, and the yard. As necessary, (a) remove partical matter from roads and other paved/work areas, (b) apply water if necessary to control emissions, (c) reduce stock pile height. A special emphasis will be placed on inspection of all applicable air pollution control devices. A record of these inspections will be maintained. Any deficiencies will be noted and action taken to remedy the deficiency.

--Provide an enclosed method of loading cement from the truck to the silo.

--Visible emissions tests of silo dust collector exhaust points will be conducted by the Safety Officer while loading the silo.

Description of Facility

Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the concrete batching plant operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. The Baker industrial/manufacturing site consists of approximately 4.5 acres located at 7740 S. George Boulevard, Sebring, FL. The site consists of a main office building, enclosed garage, covered (under roof) open garage, 6000 sq ft. under roof concrete manufacturing area, one 270 barrel capacity cement silo, and contained areas for the storage of rock and sand. Also on site is a septage waste processing area, storage for concrete septic tanks, storage for 200 portable restrooms, and an eight-bay warehouse/storage building.

Baker Septic Installations, Inc. and Baker Precast Concrete Specialties, Inc. are located at this site. Baker Septic Installations, Inc. provides on-site waste water systems for residential, industrial, and commercial facilities. Baker Precast is the on site production company for concrete septic tanks and other precast concrete products.

The cement silo consists of one (1) 270 barrel capacity (1080 cu.ft./50.8 tons) cement silo with a 7' 8" discharge height, 8' 6" diameter complete with the following standard features: Top mounted dust collector with 150 sq. ft. cloth area; Air vibrating bag shaker; Eight (8) externally mounted aeration pads with manifold; Solenoid valve for aerating silo during batching; Air line moisture trap and regulator; Emergency slide gate; 4" cement fill pipe.

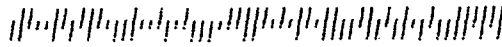

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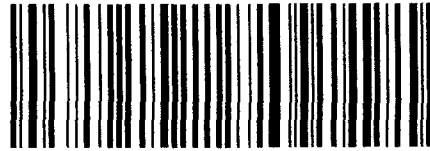

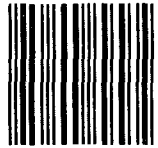
