Jason,

Ms. Pons and I inspected Signature Cleaners 0571225 on 1/26/2010 and found that the facility is no longer using perchloroethylene as a dry cleaning solvent. Based on a review of the file, the perc dry cleaning machine formerly on-site has been dismantled and removed from the site. The remaining perc was manifested off-site by Safety Kleen (copy in the file). The facility now uses a Union HL 860, S/N 607-0814, manufactured in 2006 which uses DF-2000 as the cleaning solvent. Based on our review, the facility is no longer eligible for a Perchloroethylene Dry Cleaner Air General Permit and the facility should be inactivated in ARMS. Could you please pass this information on to Tallahassee? Attached is the inspection checklist.
