January thru December 2005 our total pounds of resin and gel coat was 268,444 lbs. This year was our largest year ever. The facility was running at more than full capacity at that time. Great American Marble has never come close since and never aspires to again.

Description of Facility

Cultured marble tops to be poured are rolled into the Binks spray booth (with paint pocket filters) exhausts air through round air ducts (joints of air ducts sealed) that go approximately ten feet above roof of building. The gel goat spray gun is the Venus Magnum "F.I.T" system designed to lower emissions. Products are then mixed and poured onto the gel coated molds. Product then transferred into grinding room to remove small amount of excess material. The grinding room has an exhaust fan with filters that do not allow any dust to go to the outside. Product is then transferred to the finishing department which buffs out minor scratches. This room also has an exhaust fan with filters to stop dust from exiting the building. These fans were designed and installed by Ventilation Systems. These are the same fans in place since our permit was issued.
