C & W BAGHOUSE (MODEL # RA-140) HAS A TOTAL CLOTH AREA OF 1,400 SQ. FT., REVERSE AIR CLEANING, AND A 99% CONTROL EFFICIENCY. THE AIR TO CLOTH RATIO IS 4.3 TO 1 (ACFM/SQ.FT.).

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
