The Department has received the Title V General Permit Notification Form for the dry cleaning facility that you submitted on December 14, 2001.



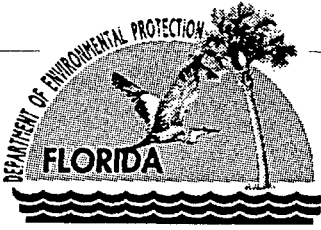

Dear Mr. Owens:

Thank you for your note received by the Department on December 20 notifying the Department of the change in status of Uptown Cleaners. The facility status has been changed to *inactive* in the database since your note indicates Uptown Cleaners is a drop store and no longer uses perchloroethylene.

Rule 62-213.300, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), stipulates that within 30 days of any changes requiring corrections to information contained in the notification form, the responsible official shall notify the Department in writing. Entitlement for Upton Cleaners was issued on January 14, 2002.

In addition, Rule 62-213.300, F.A.C., stipulates that an annual emissions fee is due and payable for the **preceding** year in which the facility was in operation and subject to the requirements of the general permit. Our records indicate Uptown Cleaners operated as a Title V general permit facility in **2002**. Therefore, the annual operation fee for which you were recently invoiced is due and payable between January 15 and March 1, 2003.
