Unpaved areas will be treated with water and/or a dust suppressant on an as-needed basis. Paved areas will be swept clean on an as-needed basis.

This is a precast operation therefore no drop points are in place for trucks. There is an enclosed chute for the cement to enter into the mixer.

Aggregate stockpiles are kept at reasonable height inside concrete walls.

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Cement is pumped into 450 bbl silo equipped with a pneumatic baghouse, fly-ash is likewise handled. Tanker drivers are instructed to pump at low rate.

Cement and/or flyash is augered to a scale then directly discharged into a Voeller Model CM-1000 3 cubic yard mixer equipped with an enclosed chute.

The plastic concrete is poured into molds to make highway barrier, portable buildings, and agricultural products.

This plant is certified by the Florida Department of Transportation, and by the National Precast Concrete Association.
