

Good morning Ms. Severns,

I hope that all is going well and I apologize for appearing to be a pest about acquiring the Page 10, Description of Facility information that was omitted from both of your registration forms, and which we discussed during our telephone conversation on Wednesday, April 14<sup>th</sup>, for both the concrete batching plant (soil cement) and the crusher unit(s) located at 14013 Tiny Morse Blvd. in Clermont.

The thirty (30) day processing & review period for these registrations will come to an end this weekend (the time clock is required by State Statute § and is unfortunately computer driven). It is important that I have the requested information today in order for these entitlements to be issued. Without the information your entitlement to operate will be denied and I would really don't want that to happen. If there is anything I can do to assist you, please, let me know.
