There are some clarifications that I need with regard to the equipment list which you have provided.

1. **Crusher Feed Conveyor #16A** references the location as *"On 8'x29' screen"*, but there is no reference or listing of a 8'x29' screen on your equipment list
2. **Conveyor #31** references the location as *"Transfer from 8'x24' to 5'x10' screen"*, but there is no reference or listing of a 5'x10' screen on your equipment list.
3. **Conveyor #32** also references *"5' x 10' underscreen reversing conveyor"*.
4. **Conveyor #21** references the location as *"Belt under Trio crusher #2"*, but the three Trio crushers are not labeled as either #1, #2, or #3. Which is which?
5. **Conveyor #33** references the location as *"Return to Trio #2"*, but again which Trio crusher is #2?
6. **Conveyor #17** location is shown as blank on your equipment list. What is it's status?

Please use the following description and let me know if you should need further information:

The non-metallic mineral (limerock excavation and crushing) processing operation at this facility consists of the following activities. First, limerock is excavated with draglines and small excavators without dewatering the excavation area. Next, the wet material is moved directly to either a mobile baserock crusher located near the primary dragline where the material is crushed at a rate of approximately 1,000 tons per hour as material is needed for purchase and removal from the site by contract haulers; or it is moved to a central fixed set of three crushers, each with a capacity of approximately 1,000 tons per hour. from each of the fixed crushers are equipped with water sprays on the conveyors for dust control. Water from a mobile spray unit is used to control dust at the product storage area located near the crushers and from the haul road to and from the crushers. Rainfall runoff to the 25-year, 3-day event and washwater is totally retained within the site. The excavation equipment is a minor source of hydrocarbon emissions
