Scruggs Concrete's Madison plant maintains all roads/parking/yards by making sure they are clear of any debris or sand. We remove particulate matter by the use of the front end loader. We have paved our parking areas to ensure minimal dust. We periodically use water throughout the day to suppress any free flow of dust. Our stock pile height is at a safe standard. We have paved the yard to ensure minimal dust. We use a dust collector to suppress excess dust.

Description of Facility

This facility is used for batching Ready-Mix Concrete. During the batching process we use a dust collector to minimize dust particles. The facility consists of 4 mixer trucks, 1 front end loader, and 1 over the road truck. We have paved the roads and continuously throughout the day wash down the yard to minimize dust.

We have two silos on our Madison Plant. 1 silo conatins 105 tons of fly ash and our second silo contains 97 ton of cement (this is the max copacity of both). Both silos are equipped with a dust collector manufactured by CnW manufacturing and the filter model # is RA140 5 x 101 (this is a central dust collector) . The dust collector is also active during the batching process. Koogler & Ass. out of Gainesville Florida handles all of our up to date paperwork dealing with the dust collector.
