

Description of Facility

ADESA Sarasota operates three fully enclosed single car Garmat spray paint booths ventilated at negative pressure. The facility has no preparation stations and spray paint booths are equipped with Superior Glass Fiber PA-22 filters which have a average removal efficiency of 99.5 percent. Spray gun applications utilize high volume, low pressure (HVLP) technology. HVLP spray guns utilized in spray booth applications consist of a Satajet 3000 and Iwata LS400 which have a transfer efficiency of 64 and 65 percent respectively. Spray guns are cleaned via hand-washing using Non-Hazardous Air Pollutant products. In addition the facility utilizes a Safety-Kleen 1107 paint thinner recycler. The facility has one sublet painter who has been trained and certified on spray gun equipment selection, spray techniques, maintenance, and environmental compliance.

The facility shall not emit nor has the potential to emit 10 tons per year or more of any hazardous air pollutant, 25 tons per year or more of any combination of hazardous air pollutants, or 100 tons per year or more of any other regulated air pollutant. In addition, the total quantity of Volatile Organic Compounds in all coatings used shall not exceed forty-four (44) pounds per day. ADESA Sarasota shall maintain paint-purchase records and record any equipment changes and/or alterations that might affect facility operations.

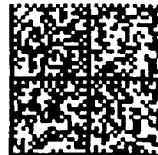

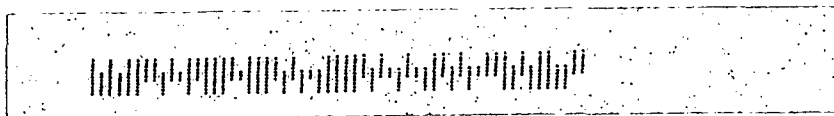
