

Good afternoon,

I do apologize for missing your call, but it's been one of those crazy Fridays.

As far as the description of the locations they are all as follows:

None have a paint booth since our spraying is done outside and involves only spot repairs. We have reviewed our procedures and even with the new EPA regulations coming in effect in 2011 we would still be allowed to continue as is since we spray from 3oz cups and therefore would not be governed by this new regulation. When it comes to our VOC usage we keep a daily log of our use and as described in our applications even estimating higher than our busiest days we are well below the allowed usage.

I hope this information is in line with what need and I apologize for not including a more detailed description in the applications.

Good morning Geidy!

I just hung up the phone from leaving you a message and realized that I had your e-mail address, so thought I would also send my request to you.

On page seven (7) of each of the forms it asks the following:

"Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the surface coating operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. Describe all air pollutant-emitting processes and equipment at the facility, and identify any air pollution control measures or equipment used."

The answers provided on each form seem somewhat generic in nature and don't really describe all of the equipment other than the "use of HVLP guns" and it is a "spot" repairs operation. See below.

ANSWERS PROVIDED: "Spot repairs on cars done using HVLP guns and none of the chemicals controlled by the new EPA Paint Stripping and Miscellaneous Surface Coating Operations Area Source Rule CFR Part 63 Subpart HHHHHH."

This answer doesn't really provide a description of the process or the pollution control equipment as requested on the form.

For example:

- 1) Is/are there a paint booth(s)?
- 2) If so, is there a manufacturer name/type/size? and
- 3) If enclosed, does the facility it have a filter system and if so, what is the type/size? or
- 4) Is the painting done in the open air, a building, or other type of full or partial enclosure?

I just need a few more details on each facility's surface coating operations in order to continue the review process.

You may e-mail the information to me for each facility and I will attach each as an addendum to the appropriate form.

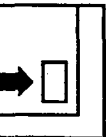
