

Comments:

Each crusher and the Powerscreen have a feed hopper. Truck dumping of nonmetallic minerals into any screening operation, feed hopper or crusher is exempt from the requirements of 40 CFR 60, Subpart OOO.

There is a grizzly feeder associated with Cedar Rapids Crusher 1833. Per 40 CFR 60, Subpart OOO, it is not considered a screen.

There is a wobbler associated with the Cedar Rapids Crusher 1840. According to facility personnel, the wobbler does not have mesh surface; therefore, it is not considered a screen, per 40 CFR 60, Subpart OOO.

The Powerscreen (2817) is also permitted under 7774814-004-AG and 7770035-002-AG.
