All five tanks use submerged filling drop tubes. All five tanks are underground tanks. Tanks #1, #2, #4 and #5 have bladders in them. Tank #3 has a fiber glass primary tank in it. Tanks #3, #4 and #5 have a vapor recovery line connected to them that runs to the loading rack. The load rack has bottom loading adaptors on the loading arms for submerged filling.

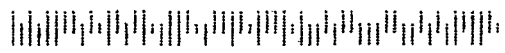
