The facility consists of an office, aggregate storage areas, batch plant, storage silos, aggregate material conveying equipment and concrete mixing trucks.

Emissions generated during pneumatic filling of the cement, flyash, and slag silos are controlled by C&W CP 305 baghouses.

Emissions generated from truck loading operations are controlled by a central dust collector. The central dust collectors is a C&W CP 900 baghouse.
